

# EU vs. DISINFORMATION: LEARNING HOW TO ACT

**CommEUnication Final Event**

#### **Overview**

The <u>CommEUnication</u> project, funded by the Europe for Citizens Program, aims to tackle Euroscepticism and to promote a broader understanding of the EU and its values.

To achieve this, the Consortium, composed of CSOs in Italy, Belgium, Bulgaria, Greece, Portugal, Ireland and France, started by a <u>survey</u> aimed to get a better and broader understanding of the disinformation phenomenon in the participating countries and to better respond to the actual needs of European citizens. On the basis of the result collected with the survey, from December 2021 to January 2022, FIDU and its partners launched <u>6 local trainings</u> to equip participants with an understanding of the concept of civic and democratic participation through the increase of their knowledge about the most debated and controversial topics in the EU. Such trainings worked as a preparatory step for the implementation of the final phase of the project, which consisted in the organization of <u>two</u> <u>international creative labs</u> in Italy and Portugal, and where participants had the opportunity to exchange their ideas with experts and develop new effective communication methods and media contents able to create a better understanding of how disinformation works in traditional and new media.

This international final conference intends to bring together the Consortium, members of the civil society and representatives of the EU institutions in order to discuss the results as well as the recommendations to policymakers and concerned stakeholders adopted by the participating partners.
